What's the purpose behind a leap year?

February is known for many things, one of which is being the shortest month of the year.

Many people do not give much thought to whether or not February has 28 or 29 days. But February bears the unique distinction of being the only month on the calendar that does not always have the same number of days.

Known as a "leap day," the 29th day of February helps to synchronize the calendar to Earth's orbit. According to EarthSky, which reports on astronomy and other cosmos-related information, Earth's orbit around the sun takes approximately 365.25 days. That extra 0.25 creates a need for a leap year every four years; otherwise, the calendar (which is faster than the actual solar year) would drift from what is actually occurring with the orbit. After four years, it would be off by one day, or 25 days after 100 years. If no corrections were made to the calendar, the seasons might become misaligned. After 300 years, Jan. 1 would arrive in autumn.

Julius Caesar, at the advice of Sosigenes, an Alexandrian astronomer, was responsible for adding a leap day to February to compensate for Earth's rotation after the original Roman calendar kept slipping out of alignment. During his reign, Caesar first implemented a 445-day calendar year in 46 BCE to bring the calendar back into alignment. Roman officials called it annus confusionis. To limit future headaches, the work-around was to simply add a leap day to February once every four years. The Julian calendar wasn't exact to the solar year, but it was much closer than the previous Roman calendar.

The Gregorian calendar, revised by Pope Gregory XIII in 1582, further adapted the calendar and the leap days. All leap years are divisible by four. That is why 2020 will include a leap day on Feb. 29.

People can utilize the extra day in 2020 in various fun ways. In addition to learning more about leap years and astronomy, try these entertaining ideas.

- Take a day off of work and spend it relaxing or engaging in a favorite hobby.
- Be reminded that leap years also coincide with U.S. Presidential elections, and it will soon be time to vote.

- Check out the celebrities who were born on Feb. 29 and only get a true birthday every four years. Rapper Ja Rule, motivational speaker Tony Robbins, actor Antonio Sabato Jr., swimmer Jessica Long and football player Eric Kendricks are some of the notable people born on Feb. 29.

- Buy a gift for yourself or others on leap day and make it a tradition of going the extra mile to love and pamper.

- Realign your life like the calendar is being realigned by focusing on organization or personal finances.

Leap year has arrived, and that extra day can be put to good use in various ways.

She was the last woman to be hanged in New York State. 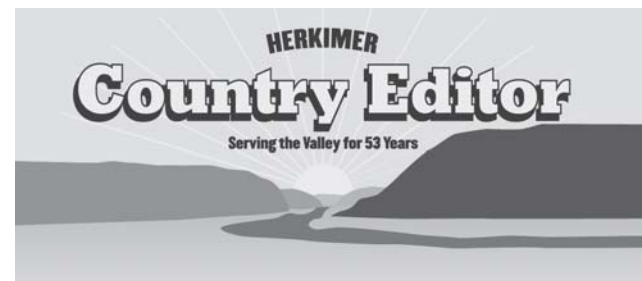

Rabid red fox

Herkimer County Public Health received word on Tuesday, Feb. 11 from Wadsworth Labs that a red fox

sent in to be tested for rabies on Monday, Feb. 10 from the Town of Fairfield has tested positive for rabies.

The family dogs were fighting with the red fox; the red fox was shot and sent to Wadsworth Lab for testing.

The public can protect themselves or their family pets from rabies by practicing the following:

1. Vaccinate your pets against rabies.
2. Spay or neuter all animals to reduce the number of strays.
3. Do not feed strays or handle unknown animals, wild or domestic.

Remind children and adults not to play with unknown animals (wild or domestic). If a bat is found in a house, and there is a possibility it had contact with a person or an animal in the house, call Public Health

and we will make arrangements to have the bat tested, if necessary.

Herkimer County Public Health would like to remind the public to check your pet's rabies vaccination records to make sure that they are up to date. If they are not up to date, make an appointment with their vet as soon as possible to have them vaccinated against rabies.

proposes to purchase the Remington school building. The Central Valley community voted 256-16 on Nov. 12, 2019 in favor of selling the building to Herkimer BOCES.

The next step is for residents of all 10 component districts to vote to authorize the purchase of the building by Herkimer BOCES. A simple majority vote (or 50% plus one yes vote) is required for the proposal to pass.

The proposed purchase price of the Remington building is \$1. Because of this price, Central Valley will not be penalized and will continue to receive approximately \$777,000 in state aid owed to the district from prior building projects. If the selling price were higher, the amount of state aid received by Central

Valley from prior building projects would be reduced.

At the Remington building, Herkimer BOCES provides alternative education, 6:1:1 school-based behavioral health operated in collaboration with ICAN, 8:1:1 special education, 12:1:1 special education, adult literacy, adult programs to earn high school equivalency diplomas, adult licensed practical nursing and adult certified nursing assistant training. Offices are also located there for the pre-K and migrant tutors programs.

Pathways Academy focuses on students who have had a difficult time in a traditional school structure or have to catch up on credits but have the ability to get a high school diploma. Pathways Academy classes are project-driven and infuse career and technical education.

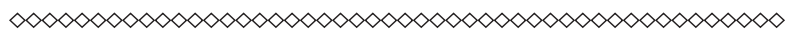

dents.

"All the skills that we give them, they can do everything in this lab," Prokopienko said. "If they're interested in learning, there is a never-ending amount of things they can learn in this room."

On the other side of the building, attendees visited a variety of school-aged academic classrooms.

Anthony Wronka, a business and math teacher for alternative education and 12:1:1 students, spoke

about how he teaches students useful skills such as knowing what to look out for on a pay-check.

Wronka also explained a hydroponics project his students are working on involving experimenting with plant growth and developing a business model for a hydroponics testing facility.

"We've got quite a garden growing in here," he said.

In eighth grade general education teacher Nycol Conigliaro's classroom, she spoke to attendees about how she helps students to use mindfulness and kindness, deal with stress and respond to any issues that come up.

"I enjoy it. I love working here," she said. "It's a great place to work."

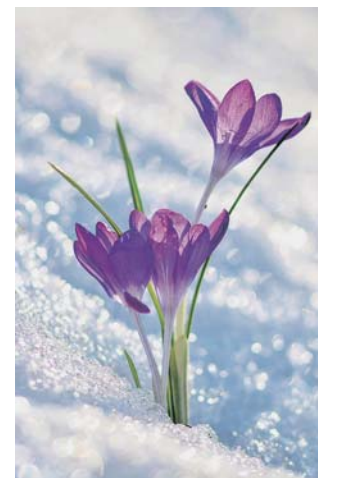
"They're catching up"

The tours ended in the Learning Center, where teaching assistants Jose Lopez and Alisa Hubbell gave a presentation about the Edmentum online credit recovery program. Students have completed 30 courses through the program since it was launched in March 2019, Lopez said.

"This catches kids up," he said. "It allows them to work at the speed they want."

Lopez, who is also a music teacher, said Edmentum offers students a chance to recover credits in core classes and take electives such as forensic science and mythology and folklore. The program alleviates pressure for students and allows them to graduate when they might not have otherwise.

"The credit recovery part makes me so happy. We are able to get students caught up," he said. "They're catching up with their classmates; they're catching up with their graduation year."

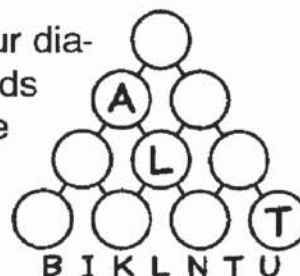
