### What's the purpose behind a leap year?

February is known for many things, one of which is being the shortest month of the year.

Many people do not give much thought to whether or not February has 28 or 29 days. But February bears the unique distinction of being the only month on the calendar that does not always have the same number

Known as a "leap day," the 29th day of February helps to synchronize the calendar to Earth's orbit. According to EarthSky, which reports on astronomy and other cosmos-related information, Earth's orbit around the sun takes approximately 365.25 days. That extra 0.25 creates a need for a leap year every four years; otherwise, the calendar (which is faster than the actual solar year) would drift from what is actually occurring with the orbit. After four years, it would be off by one day, or 25 days after 100 years. If no corrections were made to the calendar, the seasons might become misaligned. After 300 years, Jan. 1 would arrive in autumn.

Julius Caesar, at the advice of Sosigenes, an Alexandrian astronomer, was responsible for adding a leap day to February to compensate for Earth's rotation after the original Roman calendar kept slipping out of alignment. During his reign, Caesar first implemented a 445-day calendar year in 46 BCE to bring the calendar back into alignment. Roman officials called it annus confusionis. To limit future headaches, the work-around was to simply add a leap day to February once every four years. The Julian calendar wasn't exact to the solar year, but it was much closer than the previous Roman calendar.

The Gregorian calendar, revised by Pope Gregory XIII in 1582, further adapted the calendar and the leap days. All leap years are divisible by four. That is why 2020 will include a leap day on Feb. 29.

People can utilize the extra day in 2020 in various fun ways. In addition to learning more about leap years and astronomy, try these entertaining ideas.

# Herkimer College program on "Murder and Mayhem" set for Feb. 27

One hundred and thirty-three years ago, Roxalana Druse was hanged on Feb. 28, 1887 behind the old 1834 Jail for the crime of killing her husband William in the town of Warren. She was the last woman to be hanged in New York State. On Thursday, Feb. 27 the Herkimer County Historical Society is presenting the program "Murder & Mayhem in Herkimer County" based on their new book at 6:30 p.m. at Herkimer College, sponsored by the Herkimer College History Club. The presenters are contributing authors to the book and are all affiliated with Herkimer College. Ted Adams and Jim Greiner are both alumnae, Kelsey Denton is a current student, Angela Harris is a retired professor and Jeff Steele is a professor of history and social science.

# Local school board members learn about BOCES programs during Remington school tours

Local school board members recently toured the Remington school building in Ilion to find out more about the Herkimer-Fulton-Hamilton-Otsego BOCES programs located there ahead of an upcoming public vote on whether Herkimer BOCES should purchase the building from Central Valley.

Herkimer BOCES Pathways Academy Student Council member Veronica Cavaretta led one of the tour groups through the school-aged and adult education classrooms at the Remington building and spoke about her experiences at the school.

"I just want them to realize I love going here," Cavaretta said. "At first I wasn't, but now I feel so comfortable here, and I feel like I can be myself."

Herkimer BOCES hosted the open Technical Education Conference Room house tours on Tuesday, Feb. 4, at the former Remington Elementary School building at 77 E. North St. Administrators, teachers and staff were on hand, and teachers in each classroom talked about what they teach, projects their students are working on and how they help students.

proposes to purchase the Remington school building. The Central Valley community voted 256-16 on Nov. 12, 2019 in favor of selling the building to Herkimer BOCES.

The next step is for residents of all 10 component districts to vote to authorize the purchase of the building by Herkimer BOCES. A simple majority vote (or 50% plus one yes vote) is required for the proposal to pass.

The proposed purchase price of the Remington building is \$1. Because of this price, Central Valley will not be penalized and will continue to receive approximately \$777,000 in state aid owed to the district from prior building projects. If the selling price were higher, the amount of state aid received by Central

Valley from prior building projects would be reduced.

At the Remington building, Herkimer BOCES provides alternative education, 6:1:1 school-based behavioral health operated in collaboration with ICAN, 8:1:1 special education, 12:1:1 special education, adult literacy, adult programs to earn high school equivalency diplomas, adult licensed practical nursing and adult certified nursing assistant training. Offices are also located there for the pre-K and migrant tutors programs.

Pathways Academy focuses on students who have had a difficult time in a traditional school structure or have to catch up on credits but have the ability to get a high school diploma. Pathways Academy classes are project-driven and infuse career and technical education.



"This catches kids up," he said. "It allows them to work at the speed they want."


